Connect On:** Same as **preschool**, **except 4** glue sticks and does **NOT** need 3 ring binder, page protectors or 5 oz. cups. **Add:** 1 notebook and 1 water bottle and individual wrapped snack for **EACH DAY. PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS.**

Wrap Around:

Same as **Preschool** (DO NOT need binder or page protectors) plus a paint shirt in a Ziploc bag **P.M. and All Day Friday** also need 1 nap mat, blanket and pillow to be left at school.

Kindergarten:

PLEASE LABEL THE FOLLOWING: 2 boxes of 24 crayons, 1 box 12 Crayola colored pencils, 24 #2 pencils, 8 glue sticks, 1 box Crayola classic color markers, 1 bottle Elmer's liquid glue,1 plastic pencil box (5 ³/₄ X 8 ¹/₂), 1 pair Fiskar scissors, 1 8-color water color paint set, 2 wide ruled spiral notebooks, 2 pocket folders, small blanket or towel and small pillow in cloth bag for quiet time, 1 water bottle to keep at school, extra uniform labeled in Ziploc bag including underwear and socks in case of accidents or spills, Headphones (no ear-buds) for listening to iPad.

PLEASE DO NOT LABEL THE FOLLOWING: 1 ream of white copy paper, 1 large box Kleenex, 1 pkg dry erase markers, 2 large boxes of INDIVIDUALLY packaged crackers/snack to be shared with class, 2 container Clorox wipes, 1 pkg coffee filters.

Grade 1:

2 box of 24 crayons, 3 pocket folders with pockets across the bottom, 2 wide ruled spiral notebooks, 24 pencils, 1 pencil box, scissors, a paint shirt, water color paint, a backpack, 2 large boxes kleenex, small bottle of Elmer's glue, 8 glue sticks, 2 packs of markers, 1 ream white copy paper, 4 dry erase markers, 2 Clorox wipes, headphones (for listening to computer) **PLEASE LABEL water colors, folders, headphones, scissors and pencil box.**

Grades 5-8:
