St. Mary School has contracted hot lunch from the New Richmond School District for a number of years. This partnership has been a blessing to our school in that we can offer nutritious meals to our students and has removed a burden of debt from the school budget. Since the first contract with the New Richmond School District, the DPI has made many changes in policies, trainings, and audit practices. This spring St. Mary School went through the hot lunch audit, and it was a task that required a large number of man hours. The school passed the audit with flying colors, but it did open our eyes to the coming changes and how we should best approach them. After many meetings of collaboration with the New Richmond School District, we were offered a proposal for the District to take complete control of our hot lunch program. This proposal will be presented to the New Richmond School District Board for approval on Monday, May 20th. The benefits of this action would be the following:

- No price increase for the 2019-2020 school year
- All employees would be staffed from the district
- A wider variety of menu choices for students
- Ala carte items added for older students
- A share cart will be added mid-year
- All paper work, training, and audit documentation done by the District
- All transactions would become electronic through the District
- Would reduce payroll and benefits in the school's annual budget

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• Would eliminate the need for the Mary Mobile, thus not having maintenance and insurance on the vehicle.


