Dear Parents & Students,

What a great start to the school year. I love seeing all the bright and smiling faces each morning! As we wrap up the second week of school I would like to remind everyone of a few procedural items.

- ~When picking up students at the end of the day please wait outside by the playground doors. If at all possible please do not pick students up in classrooms as it is a distraction for other students.
- ~When entering the school parking lot please enter north of the church from Pershing. Please do not enter the wrong way off of Washington.
- ~Please keep your speed down in the parking lot for the safety of everyone.

On Tuesday, August 23rd the faculty and staff of the school and church were trained for an active intruder/shooter to the building. We teamed with the New Richmond Police Department and School District for the training. I am happy to report that I received very positive feedback on how well prepared we are. I was proud of the faculty and staff and how quick thinking they were in problem solving various safety scenarios. In the weeks to come I will be visiting each classroom to discuss with the students what they will need to do in the event of an active intruder/shooter in the building. All discussions will be age appropriate to each class. In November we will be having a drill with the students. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to visit, email, or call me. I know this is a scary subject but unfortunately it is one I have to discuss with the students to keep them safe.

On Friday, September 23rd, I will be visiting St. Joseph School in Rice Lake for a pre-accreditation meeting. I will be chairing their accreditation team in late October. On Monday & Tuesday, September 26th & 27th, I will be out of the office also. I will be assisting St. Anne School in Somerset with their accreditation process. Mrs. Mitchell be will in touch with me by phone if I am needed for any reason.
