The "Momo Challenge" is a game found on various online sites including YouTube, KidsYouTube, and social media apps. This challenge features an avatar who asks its viewers to perform various tasks and provide photos as proof. In a "Momo Challenge," children are encouraged to participate in dangerous behavior, threaten or harm other children, and has even suggested suicide. In this age of social media challenges I urge you to monitor your child's social media and internet usage. 


