We have a lot of exciting things going on in the building this year. The Chromebooks are up and ready for student use, the teachers have new laptops, and our network is receiving an overhaul with a new firewall, switches, and 4 commercial strength wireless modems. It is an online program and background check that can be completed in your home at any time. There is no cost to you, but the Diocese of Superior requires this training for all adults who will be interacting with students. Please contact me for information on the training.

Included in your family folder is the Diocesan Advocates Annual Income Eligibility Parent Survey form. It is very important that each family complete this and return to the school. It allows us to receive rebates on our phone, internet, and technology expenses. These need to be returned to the office by September 18th.

Spirit Days will be held on the last Monday of every month so our first Spirit Day will be held on September 24th. On Spirit Days students may wear any spirit gear or Marathon-It shirt with uniform bottoms. Orders for this year's spirit gear will be taken until September 20th. An order form for Spirit Gear went home in the family folders today. Spirit gear makes great Christmas presents for students, parents, and grandparents!

A gentle reminder: when picking up students at the end of the day please wait outside by the playground doors. If at all possible please do not pick students up in classrooms as it is a distraction for other students and creates congestion in the hallways. I appreciate your help in making dismissal run as smooth as possible.

I am excited to announce that St. Mary School, the New Richmond School District, and the New Richmond Police Department have teamed together in adding a student resource officer. Officer Anderson will be visiting each school in the city multiple times a week to assist administration and teachers and to foster a positive relationship between students and law enforcement. Officer Anderson made his first visit to the school today and was able to introduce himself to some of the classes.
