It is hard to believe that Thanksgiving is right around the corner. There are so many things that the school has to be thankful for. We are blessed with wonderful staff, great families, and receive wonderful support of prayers and donations. In your family folder is one of those donations, it is a family prayer book. The school received them to share with families to aid in prayer life at home. I hope you will enjoy them and use them together as a family.

Did you know? Our Hearts for the Hungry Campaign (formerly the penny drive) starts on Tuesday, November 19th. It will be fun to watch as the hearts appear on the trees in the front stairwell. According to www.feedingamerica.org in Wisconsin, 578,480 people are struggling with hunger—and of them, 197,290 are children. 1 in 6 children struggles with hunger. The Hearts for the Hungry Campaign will run through Tuesday, November 26th and all proceeds will be split between 5 Loaves Food Shelf and the Thanksgiving Day dinner.

WRISA Accreditation Goals: Now that our site visit is over, we have settled into the routine of the school year. The faculty will be spending the Professional Learning Day on November 18th beginning to create our WRISA goals. Future in-service days will be spent on developing and writing the goals. This will be a long and arduous process but will lead to bringing our school to an even higher level than it is already at. Once the goals are completed, they will be reviewed by the Ministry of Education and the Superintendent of School for the Diocese of Superior. After that the goals will be sent to the WRISA board for approval. You can help the school with the process by keeping faculty in your prayers. Pray for them to keep Christ at the center of the goals and to look to challenge themselves and their students in academic excellence.
