Dear St. Mary School Families,

I am happy to announce that we have gone well over a month with no positive cases of COVID-19. Most of the faculty will receive their 2nd dose of the vaccination next week, and hopefully we will be able to finish out the year with little to no more cases!

Next Friday, March 26th brings the end of 3rd Quarter and the start of Spring break. Report cards will go home in the family folders on Friday, April 9th. If you are traveling over spring break please monitor all members of the family upon return for any symptoms of COVID-19. Please keep anyone home that is experiencing symptoms and do not return to school until a negative PCR test is taken.

The Hero campaign kicked off two weeks ago. This campaign is in place of our biggest fundraiser, the Mardi Gras Gala. No donation is too big or small! It costs just short of \$6,000 a year to educate a student at St. Mary School. Tuition only covers a portion of that cost, and the rest is covered through parish subsidy, donations, and school fundraisers. With the cancelation of Mardi Gras, the loss in fundraising revenues leaves a hole in the school's budget. Please prayerfully consider becoming a St. Mary School Hero and supporting our great school. 
